

Aryaman Verma, a student of Sat Paul Mittal School, is selected for the Young Scientist Program launched by ISRO



For the very first time, Indian Space Research Organisation ISRO launched a Young Scientists Program or Yuva Vigyani Karyakram' (YUVIKA 2019) for the school students on 13th Feb 2019 wherein Aryaman Verma, a student of Sat Paul Mittal School, Ludhiana is selected for the Young Scientist Program. According to ISRO, Chief Secretary selected three students who are currently studying in 9th standard from every state to participate in this program. The aim of ISRO is to impart basic knowledge of Space Technology, space science & Space applications to young minds to arouse their interest in Space activities. The training program will be of two weeks duration during summer holidays.

The Young Scientist Programme would be conducted across 4 centres of ISRO, which includes the Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre, Space Application Centre and Bangalore, during the second half of May 2019.
